#### The Installation of the 20th Dean



His and Hers: Questions from a Young Couple



A Note about the Class: Not long ago, a young couple asked me to officiate at their wedding. I knew them well and was glad to be asked. I also guessed that in matters of faith they had as many questions as convictions. I asked them if they would like to bring their questions to our premarital counseling discussions. And so they did. This Sunday morning series takes up their questions.

**November 29: His:** I believe in Christian values and will strive to live my life in what I believe to be a Christian manner but I have struggled with achieving certainty in my belief in God. In my mind, there is just no way to really know what's truly going on. What are your thoughts on that worldview?

**December 6: Hers:** When you have questions about faith or religion, how do you go about trying to answer them? How do you go about exploring different concepts of faith and religion? Through books? Inner reflection? Discussion with others? Etc.

December 13: His: What questions have you thought about the most? Have you been able to reach answers?

December 20: Hers: What do you do when you disagree with something within your religion or in the Bible?

#### Peter Hartstein to Share his Holocaust Experience



The Cathedral is pleased to have so many wonderful, giving and loyal members. All of us have unique experiences and much to share with each other. We are truly a House of Prayer for ALL People! Parishioner Peter Harstein will meet with the children in Level III Atria in Mitchell house at 10:00 a.m. on December 6 to share his experience as a Holocaust survivor. All are welcome to join in either of these conversations. He will speak to the EYC in January. Peter was born in January 1937 in Stuttgart Germany. His father was sent to the concentration camps two times, and was released in June 1945 when the allies arrived. Peter's father was a Jew, but his mother was a Lutheran. This mixed marriage saved Peter and his siblings from being sent to the concentration camps. However, his grandparents and his sister all lost their lives in Auschwitz. Peter and the rest of his family came to Little Rock on November 28, 1947. Peter still remembers in July 1944 when they were bombed out of Stuttgart. Everything was on fire,

however he and his family were saved by an anonymous man with a wagon who placed wet towels over them and led them to safety. We look forward to welcoming Peter to the Atria and EYC as he tells the story of his father and his family during this time.
